- **N**EW ministries
- **E**NLIST parishioners through direct, personal contact
- **C**OMMUNICATE frequently

● **W.O.R.K.** with your community

- **W**ANT an energetic Missions and Evangelism ministry
- **O**PEN up your parish. Provide opportunities for inquirers/non-Orthodox to “Come and See”
